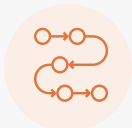

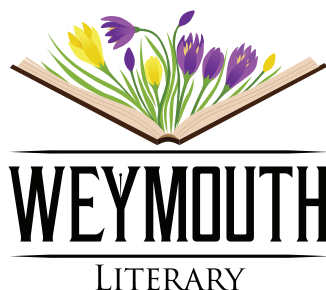


The Arts & Humanities

During this year, over
100 volunteers donated
over **10,000 hours**
of service.

Literary

- We called upon our talented Writers-in-Residence and other North Carolina writers for several Author Events. Dawn Reno Langley shared her book *Analyzing the Prescotts*, Tim Tyson joined us in February and read from his book, *Blood Done Sign My Name*. March brought Julia Hans who wrote *Hidden History of Pinehurst*.
- The Writers-in-Residence (WIR) program hosted many talented writers including Wiley Cash who recorded his Our State Book Club Podcast from the NC Literary Hall of Fame.
- The Moore County Writers' Competition in April 2024 brought 140 talented writers from all age groups with 56 winning entries. The field was so large that the awards ceremony was divided between the Adult and Student entries with two different ceremony dates.
- In April 2024, we celebrated National Poetry Month with a riveting Poetry Slam featuring 25 local speakers and daily social media posts sharing poems. We hosted the annual Poetry by the Pond event with three Writers-in-Residence and a lawn full of poetry lovers.
- Our James Boyd Book Club continues to thrive, convening monthly on the 3rd Tuesday at 2 pm with many of the authors joining in to chat about their work.
- The new 'Welcome Lending Library' offers books that are on the challenged list as well as books by our Writers-in-Residence. These books may be checked out anonymously and returned at will.



Performing Arts

- Throughout the year, Weymouth Center showcased the richness of the performing arts with a variety of performances in our 'Chamber Sessions' series including the Boston Public Quartet in partnership with Emmanuel Episcopal Church. The quartet performed a concert for local students the next day in our Great Room. Nicholas Susi, a pianist described as 'an innovative musician and aggressive thinker with a gift for keyboard brilliance', and Nick DiEugenio (violinist) & Mimi Solomon (pianist) a brilliant husband and wife duo rounded out the performances.
- Our 'Come Sunday Jazz Series' of delightful Sunday morning outdoor concerts were very well received. In partnership with UNC Pembroke, we were honored to feature Kenni Holman who was a member of the legendary Prince's horn section. The Matt White Quartet, The Mint Julep Jazz Band, Lucy Yeghiazaryan and the 'Artist of the Violin' Brooke Alford, who had a local connection, all helped to fill the lawn on Sunday afternoons.
- The 'Live from the Great Room' series welcomed an adventurous trumpet and accordion duo, Eric and Will, who played evocative original compositions with sounds from jazz, classical and folk music. We also enjoyed Larry Bellorín and Joe Troop who offered a bilingual program of virtuosic fusion music (harp, banjo, cuatro, fiddle, upright bass, guitar, maracas, singing), storytelling, humor, and singalongs.
- We continue the spirit of musical camaraderie with the popular 'Musicians' Song Circle,' hosting live music-in-the-round jam sessions each month.
- Arranged outreach opportunities for many of our performers and authors to speak and perform at community locations like Penick Village, Moore Montessori, Episcopal Day School, Southern Pines Elementary School.



Youth and Family

- Our innovative 'Master Class Mondays' program connected Weymouth's guest artists with Moore County Public Schools for many in-school visits over the course of the year, enriching students' creative experiences. The artists also visited the neighboring Senior Living Center at Penick Village to entertain the residents.
- To entertain young visitors, a fun Scavenger Hunt was created to send families searching the grounds for various objects. Young scavengers were encouraged to use their senses to see, hear, and feel the various animals and plants on the property.
- An Instrument Petting Zoo was created in partnership with the North Carolina Arts Council and Arts Council of Moore County to offer an array of wind, string, and percussion instruments to young musicians who attended our concerts.
- The Spring Into Reading Festival brought many community partners to our grounds for a storytelling event with crafts and games. The Dolly Parton Imagination Library signed up new readers while the Country Bookshop and other vendors shared their wares.
- Two new Free Little Libraries were erected on the grounds and they house a carefully curated array of books that are free to children and adults.



Equestrians

- Weymouth Equestrians, a program that was introduced in 2023, expanded in 2024. The afterschool program at the Weymouth Stables in partnership with the Sandhills Boys & Girls Club creates opportunities for all youth to learn to ride horses and experience equestrian life. Fall 2024 saw the enrollment of 20 young equestrians aged 8-13. The barn now houses six horses and an array of tack and gear curated by willing volunteers.
- "Hounds on the Grounds," the annual Moore County Hounds Hunt Meet returned to Weymouth in January 2024.
- The second annual "Horses Benefit Kids" Kentucky Derby watch party and fundraiser raised more than \$50,000 in support of Weymouth Equestrians



Diversity, Equity, Inclusion, and Belonging

- In the Spring of 2023, conducted a Community Needs Assessment that revealed a greater need for more accessible programming, lower ticket prices, more family-focused and free events.
- Hosted monthly events year-round that amplified the voices and art of marginalized communities.
- Sandhills PRIDEfest returned to the grounds at Weymouth Center in June 2024.
- Launched the Weymouth Welcome Lending Library to make books by NC authors, books by Weymouth Center Writers-in-Residence, and children's books free and available to all, and partnered with the National Freedom to Read Campaign to make banned books accessible to all.
- Launched a Diversity, Equity, Inclusion and Belonging Committee of the Board of Directions, with a focus on internal training in implicit bias, building access and opportunities in the arts & humanities for all, and intentionally building a more inclusive Weymouth Center.

 - A wine-tasting event "Ladies Wine Out".
 - The annual Strawberry Festival Luncheon.
 - Women of Weymouth supported numerous other community based events such as Spring Into Reading, Peaches and Powercars, Peach Grass Festival, and the summer Drive-In.

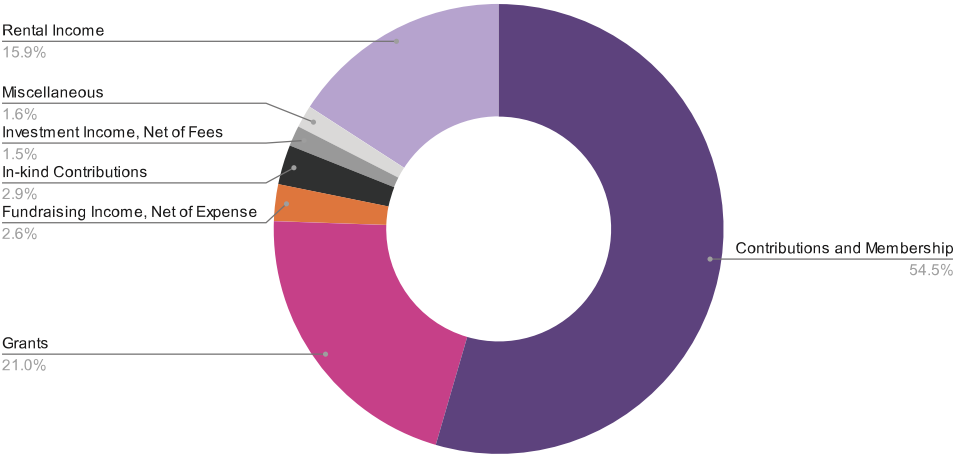

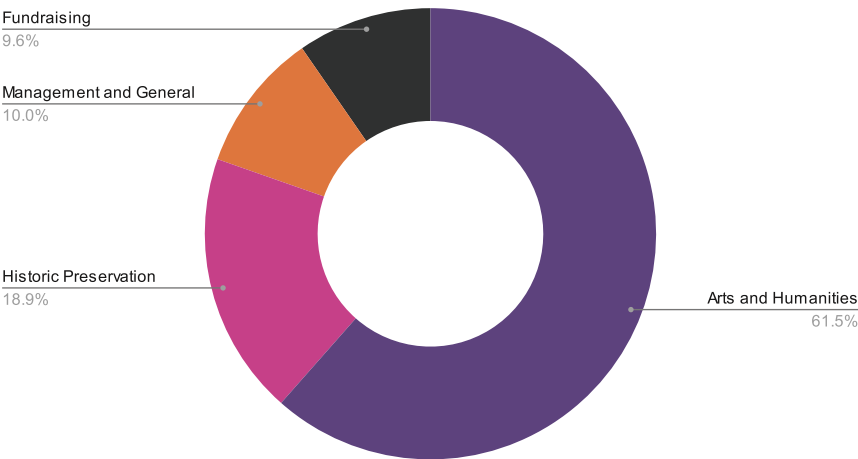
